<u>Union:</u> We Are going to hold this grievance Pending Union.

Company: Correct me if I'm wrong. You're not sure who delivered the router or not?

Union: Yes

<u>Company</u>: Was it delivered? We're unsure at this time. Looked up the 2023 report and UPS, FedEx, Or an Assistant tech. None of these people delivered a router in 2023. I don't know when the job was. Possible it was delivered in 2022.

<u>Union:</u> Customer obtains the router through UPS, FedEx, US mail. When the router is online would it be registered?

Company: I would think so. There's an install step.

<u>Union</u>: So, its registered and you move from Apartment to apartment is the router up and running with the same info?

Company: I don't know if there are steps for that.

Union: Do you pay monthly?

Company: Don't pay monthly.

Union: is it owned?

Company: Not paying a rental fee. It's waived.

Union: Waived for a period or infinite?

Company: Its unclear. Part of a promotion.

<u>Union:</u> Company waives the initial fee for customer. Not sure if for a period or forever. Does the company view this service as owned by the customer or does the company maintain ownership?

Company: Neither.

Union: Can you elaborate?

Company: It's owned by Wells Fargo.

<u>Union:</u> Customer goes to Comcast are they required to send the router back?

<u>Company</u>: The expectation is to return the router, I believe.

<u>Union</u>: Wells Fargo is a 3rd party owner of the routers?

Company: All Routers. Verizon is in the pipeline.

<u>Union:</u> You indicated Wells Fargo owns the router prior. Is a customer required to return the router if they leave Verizon?

Company: I think so.

Union: When did Wells Fargo come into the mix?

Company: Roughly 2014.

<u>Union:</u> Wells Fargo have proprietary exclusions rights or privileges between the customers. Router returned by the customer or subsidiary. We believe that this grievance lays claim to this work. FSC was involved with this customer to the point where they walked a customer through various processes. We feel this is a Violation of Articles 2,8,12,17,39,40,41, the Letter on Pg.28 and the 2008 Buried Loop Agreement. Pay Terrence 2 hours for each job to settle this grievance.

<u>Company:</u> Part of the FCSA's responsibility is to help customers navigate any problems they might have. Don't see a problem there. Wells Fargo owns the routers. This grievance is denied.

<u>Union:</u> We will close this grievance in disagreement, PUA.

<u>Company:</u> Don't know who delivered the router. UPS, FedEx didn't deliver the router to the customer. Routers are owned by Wells Fargo.

<u>Union:</u> Is there a customer agreement disclaimer? In the Customer agreement does it say they are required to return the equipment at the expiration of the contract fulfillment?

Company: Customer is expected to return the router.

<u>Union:</u> If it's owned by Verizon then we believe this grievance lays claim to previous grievances where Tech See was used and it circumvented a Service tech dispatch where the router is owned and operated by Verizon. Pay Antoine Johnson 2 hours 2 settle this grievance.

<u>Company</u>: This is not viewed as a Violation of Article 17. Router is not owned by Verizon. Relative to the FCSA. Their job is to help customers navigate through issues. The company sees no Violation. FCSA job is to help resolve problems. Therefore, this grievance is denied.

<u>Union</u>: We Will close this grievance is Disagreement, PUA. Company is In Violation of Articles 2,8,12,17,39,40,41, the letter on Pg. 28 and the 2008 Buried Loop Agreement.

<u>Union:</u> Tom Kleinschmidt, Service tech, was dispatched on tickets DQ0FYMPT, DQ0FYPZR, DQ0FYRXK, DQ0FYS14, DQ0FYRTS, DQ0FYS6U, DQ0FYSFD, DQ0FZ2N1, DQ0FZ57R, DQ0FZ7QL, DQ0FZ8TR, and discovered that the company directly shipped equipment to the customers via UPS. Based on info, can you confirm the Tech see app was used?

Company: I don't know if it was.

Union: Any reason to believe Tech See is not being used anymore?

Company: It's still being used.

Union: Each and every call?

Company: Definitely not the case.

Union: Can you provide instances?

Company: FSC supervisor says Tech See is only used 20% of the time.

<u>Union:</u> In Instances it is not used or to better clarify the question. Each time the customer calls the FSC Tech See is not used or no dispatch because the FSC used a FECO ticket? Is that accurate?

<u>Company:</u> There will be times we use a FECO ticket. FSC doesn't utilize it every time talking to customers.

<u>Union:</u> Is it fair to say, based on Company policy, procedures, directives, that no FECO was used because of a dispatch?

Company: I agree.

<u>Union:</u> In previous cases the FSC some way resolved the issue successfully. So, would you agree there was no truck roll?

Company: the odds are we usually don't.

<u>Union:</u> The customers were not Union Members?

Company: They are not.

<u>Union:</u> Not members so our position is the same. The Tech See App was used to circumvent thew trouble. FIOS in a Box was used after the pandemic ended. Walked customers through it to avoid a Service tech dispatch. Tech See is used on every call and is a Blatant violation of the 2008 Buried Loop Agreement, exclusive to CWA. Pay Tom Kleinschmidt 2 hours for each ticket to settle the grievances.

<u>Company</u>: Part of the FSCA responsibility is to help customers. Tech See is used as part of their work. The company sees no violation and this grievance is denied.

Union: CID, PUA.

<u>Union:</u> Ed Grove, Service tech, was dispatched on tickets DQ0FZPQG, DQ0G0KB1, DQ0G0KVP, DQ0G0M11, where the customer was instructed to repair the job on their own. Would you say in these instances there was no FECO ticket?

Company: I would.

Union: The Customer called the FSC and there was no resolve, so a tech was sent out?

Company: Yes.

Union: If the FSC did resolve the issue would there have been a truck roil?

Company: Probably not.

<u>Unions:</u> Our position is that the FSC saw an opportunity to keep using the Tech See app after the pandemic ended, to try and walk customers through their issues and avoid dispatching a Service Tech at all costs. We feel the Tech See app is used on every call into the FSC. Service techs have been going into homes freely and willfully for years now. We feel this is a Blatant violation of the 2008 Buried Loop Agreement. We feel this work is exclusive to CWA Local 13000 Bargaining Unit. Pay Ed 2 hours overtime, cease and desist the use of Tech See to settle this grievance.

<u>Company:</u> Part of the FSCA job function. FSC associate will continue to work with the customer. This grievance is denied.

This is a blatant violation of the 2008 Buried Loop Agreement. This work is exclusive to CWA local 13000 Bargaining Unit. Pay each grievant 2 hours for each ticket to settle these grievances.

<u>Company:</u> We see no violation. These grievances are denied.
